County Assessors Starting Property Re-inspection Next Week

County Assessors will be travelling door-to-door during regular business hours in selected areas in the County starting Tuesday, March 3rd until further notice, to conduct property re-inspections.

“The County re-inspects properties to ensure all data assessment records are up-to-date and accurate,” says Barry Donovan, County Chief Assessor. “Some properties may not be visited as they were already re-inspected recently or nothing has drastically changed to the properties.”

County assessors will be visiting properties located within Townships 70-75 Range 5 as well as in the Town of Wembley and Village of Hythe. Townships 70-75 Range 5 are located in areas east of the City of Grande Prairie, in the eastern parts of Wedgewood, Clairmont and Sexsmith; and Webster. Other areas of the County have already been re-inspected.

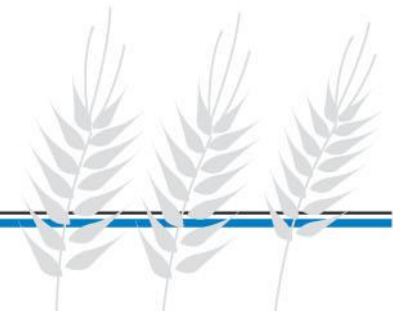
Property re-inspection is a standard policy put in place by the provincial government that requires all Alberta municipalities perform every five years.

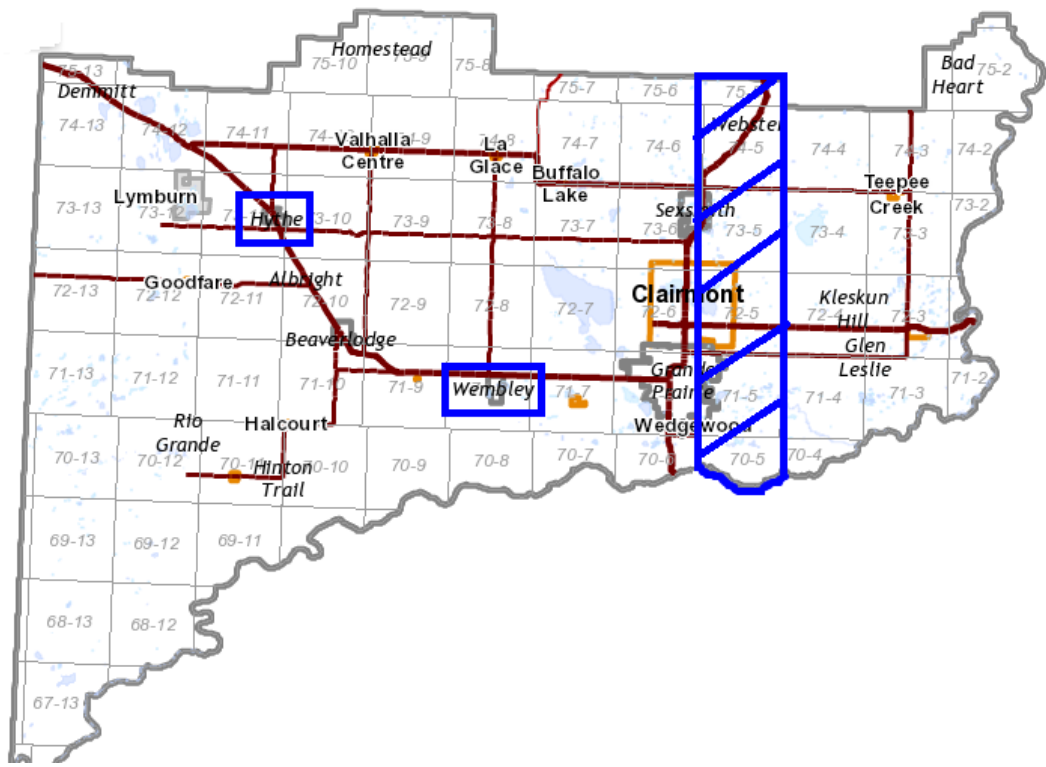
